

Harvest Bible Chapel Spring Lake Worship Team Attire Guidelines

"...whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." 1 Cor 10:30

The Harvest Worship Team desires to lead congregants in spirit and truth-filled worship, directed vertically toward God. We accomplish this through our music, lyrics, and stage presence. We recognize the importance of physical appearance in drawing other's gaze upward, both through our body language and through our attire. The following guidelines for attire are expected for all members of the worship team on stage:

Members of the worship team should look clean and neat. Generally, your clothing or accessories should not attract special attention, distract, or cause lustful thoughts by those we are leading in worship. Examples of this include excessive or gaudy jewelry and clothing with holes or excessive tearing. Everyone, but especially women, be careful to not wear clothing that is too low , too short, or pants and shirts that are too tight and form fitting.

Without getting too legalistic with measurements etc, we trust that you will be able to discern what would attract attention to you in the wrong way. If you are questioning something, a good rule is to play it safe. Please feel free to contact me, Pastor Chris, with any additional questions, or Carolyn if you prefer a female contact. The pastoral staff reserves the right to amend or revise these guidelines if needed. In the event that the pastoral staff feels your attire is inappropriate, you will be approached by Chris, if male, or Carolyn, if female, and asked to make arrangements to wear something different.
